Specifically:

- To be willing to share their contact details, phone numbers and email address with other parents/carers in the class.
- To encourage parental participation in school life by positively promoting school events and being a conduit of information about school events.
- To be pro-active in welcoming new families who join the school.
- To ensure that all communication via social media, Whatsapp, email etc.. related to the school follows the example of Jesus and the values of the Gospel.
- To be willing to organise/co-ordinate social engagements for the parents and carers in the class to meet up. For example coffee mornings
- To be a point of contact in a school emergency (previously telephone trees) to contact parents if we needed to close the school e.g. burst water pip
- To encourage any parent/carer who has a concern to contact the appropriate member of staff in school. To assure the parent that the teacher concerned would want to be able to resolve any concerns/difficulties positively.
- To help to find parents in the class who would be willing to take a turn running the class' 'Tuck Table'.
- To support the work of the FoSD and liaise with parents in the class.
- To help recruit a successor at the end of the year!
