➤ All children will spend time with their new class teacher towards the end of this term

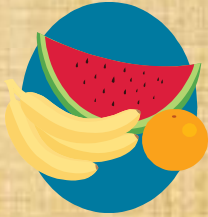




A typical day in Year 3



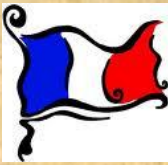
8.40 - Dropped off at the gate and the children make their own way in to class (or breakfast club available from 7.45am)



Children will stay in their classes for all subjects.

The children may be split into ability groups for spelling across Year 3.

10.45 - 11am - Breaktime - send in fruit/vegetable



12.15 - 1.10pm - Lunchtime - on a rota basis; lunchtime clubs (optional)



Afternoon lessons - new in KS2 are French lessons & ukelele lessons

3.15pm - New Collection points. The children will be collected from the KS2 playground.

After school clubs run by teachers and external providers (optional)



Homework:

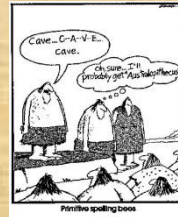


➤ Maths

- ❖ Given out on Friday, due in on Tuesday - 20 minutes maximum
- ❖ Number bonds, times tables, mental arithmetic.



➤ English



- ❖ Regular reading - more frequently for reading scheme and record in reading diary.
- ❖ Weekly homework given out Monday, due in on Thursday - 20 minutes maximum
- ❖ Weekly spelling list to be practised at home. Tested on Monday of each week.
