

Home-School Agreement

The school will uphold the mission statement by:

- Encouraging the children to do their best, to take care of others and to respect the environment around them.
- Being committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of our children.
- Contacting parents if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or equipment, and concerns that affect their child's work or behaviour.
- Ensuring parents have regular access to view their child's work, to arrange parents' evenings to enable discussion of their child's progress. Delivering an end of year report.
- School information will be made available via monthly newsletters, Schoolcomms(email), the school website, www.stdunstans.surrey.sch.uk, the school office or by request.

The parent/carer will uphold the mission statement of the school by:

- Ensuring that their child attends school regularly, is punctual, has the necessary equipment and is dressed in accordance with the school uniform policy.
- Informing the school promptly if their child is absent, including the reason why, and if there are any problems regarding their child's work or behaviour.
- Supporting all school policies and guidelines especially for behaviour, homework and attendance, and organising any family holidays outside term time.
- Attending meetings to discuss their child's progress, and making alternative arrangements when this is not possible.
- Parking considerately at all times in and around the school and not stopping on the yellow zigzag lines outside the school gates for any reason.
- Ensuring that their child does not bring a mobile phone to school under any circumstances, unless they are in Year 6 with a signed mobile phone agreement. No child may wear a smartwatch with internet access in school.

- Attending school regularly and being on time for my lessons with the equipment I need. I will always do my best, and complete my homework on time.
