







What are the teachers doing to prepare children for year 1?

- Teaching and learning is carefully planned to provide the foundations in knowledge and skills needed for Year 1
- Gradually altering the structure of the day- this helps children to begin to regulate and get used to specific times of the day e.g. play time, snack time, time to go to the toilet.
- Building stamina for learning and focusing on specific skills that will help children thrive in a Year 1 classroom
- Working closely with the Year 1 team to ensure a seamless transition

What can I do at home to prepare my child for Year 1?





What can I do at home to prepare my child for Year 1?

- Have realistic expectations- your child may be hungrier or more tired at the end of the school day. They may become more emotional as a result of having to concentrate on new skills and concepts. Some children have more wet accidents too!
- Transition Work on Google Classroom will give you ideas of ways to continue to support the learning – solid understanding of number to 10 and Phase 3 phonics
